

# Cancer Screening Programmes ATS Brianza Area

## BOWEL CANCER SCREENING

- **Who is it for?**

Men and women aged 50 to 74 who live in Lecco, Monza or the surrounding province.

- **How does it work?**

You will receive a letter every 2 years (if your last test result was normal). Take the letter to a local pharmacy to collect your free home test kit. You do the test at home.

- **Who is it for?**

Women aged 45 to 74 who live in Lecco, Monza or the surrounding province.

- **Ages 45-49:** invited once a year.
- **Ages 50-74:** invited once every 2 years.

You will receive an invitation letter if your last test result was normal.

## BREAST CANCER SCREENING (MAMMOGRAM)

## HEPATITIS C (HCV) SCREENING

- **Who is it for?**

Men and women born between 1969 and 1989, unless you have already been tested or treated for Hepatitis C.

- **How does it work?**

Bring your invitation letter to an authorised hospital blood test centre or an accredited laboratory. Only one blood sample is needed.

- **Who is it for?**

Women only.

- **Ages 25-29:** A Pap smear test every 3 years.
- **Ages 30-64:** An HPV test every 5 years.

You will receive an invitation letter if your last result was normal. The test is quick and usually painless.

## CERVICAL CANCER SCREENING

## PROSTATE CANCER SCREENING (PSA TEST)

- **Who is it for?**

Men who are registered with a General Practitioner (GP) in Lombardy and were born in 1966 or later, starting from the day they turn 50.

- **How does it work?**

Log in to your Electronic Health Record (Known as FSE - Fascicolo Sanitario Elettronico) and complete the online questionnaire to find out whether you are eligible for the PSA blood test.
